1. AI credits run out, bill shocks • Heat 9/10

Copilot switches to metered billing, Uber caps at \$1500, monthly cost anxiety

PAIN Quota exhausted only notified, overage charges uncapped, no mental preparation

EXISTING Copilot Pro+ swipes fast, AI tool pricing opaque

OPPORTUNITY Cost alerts and predictability let users use freely

COMPETITORS GitHub Copilot (opaque metering), Claude (no balance dashboard)

2. Thousands of notes, finding one is harder • Heat 8/10

Notion, WeChat Favorites, Obsidian scattered, keyword search tortuous

PAIN Cross-app search needs 8 phrasings to hit, year-old content sunk

EXISTING Notion AI reads only current page, Obsidian needs manual links

OPPORTUNITY Import all notes, ask anything and find it, I'll pay

COMPETITORS Mem.ai (no Chinese support), Microsoft Copilot (searches only OneDrive)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

3. AI output untrusted, need line-by-line check • Heat 7/10

Generated code/report looks fine, crashes on deploy, trust cost high

PAIN No time for manual review, automated tests miss logic, errors surface late

EXISTING CI tests for code but insufficient, docs lack auto-validation

OPPORTUNITY Build AI output validator, auto-check facts and code logic

COMPETITORS GitHub Copilot no validation, Grammarly only spelling

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

4. AI schedules but never understands context • Heat 6/10

Ask AI my schedule, it lists but can't tell conflicts

- PAIN** Calendar, email, tasks separate, AI assistant won't auto-merge
- EXISTING** Google Calendar no AI, Motion too expensive
- OPPORTUNITY** AI scheduler integrating calendar+email+tasks, auto-negotiate time
- COMPETITORS** Clockwise (meetings only), Reclaim (habit optimization)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

5. Multimodal AI claims image support, but text only • Heat 5/10

Send screenshot to extract table, AI describes image, data still manual

- PAIN** Poor PDF/image parsing, structured data extraction under 60%
- EXISTING** Claude supports images but low accuracy, OCR tools limited
- OPPORTUNITY** Build AI focused on document/screenshot parsing, output copyable tables
- COMPETITORS** Adobe Acrobat AI (expensive), Mathpix (academic)

7 needs • sorted by heat

1. Ai code looks like scribbles, review is exhausting • Heat 9/10

Claude writes hundreds of lines, fixing one bug creates three new ones, review time doubles

PAIN Messy logic, missing dependencies, wrong comments, need to check line by line

EXISTING GitHub Copilot doesn't verify, OpenCode review has many false positives

OPPORTUNITY Auto-mark suspicious AI code points and suggest fixes

COMPETITORS Cursor (no review), CodeRabbit (security breach history)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

2. Tried running local llm all night, failed • Heat 8/10

Mac mini 64G unsure which model, Gemma4 says 16G enough but can't install

PAIN Dependency conflicts, driver incompatibility, vram config stuck at every step

EXISTING Ollama supports few models, vLLM blows vram on consumer gpus

OPPORTUNITY Auto-detect hardware, recommend best model, one-click deploy

COMPETITORS Ollama, LM Studio both require manual tuning

3. Ide code completion overridden by ai suggestions • Heat 7/10

After VSCode update, IntelliSense gone, only Copilot hints remain

PAIN Miss traditional completion, but turning off AI feels like loss

EXISTING Manually edit editor.quickSuggestions, resets on each update

OPPORTUNITY Build plugin for harmonious coexistence of AI and IntelliSense

COMPETITORS VSCode official has no such option

For: Solo • Difficulty 2/5 • UP

4. Codex tokens spent mysteriously • Heat 7/10

Using Codex to code, burned through points in 20 minutes, no clue why

- PAIN** No real-time usage dashboard, locked after overage, no self-healing
- EXISTING** Claumon predicts but no intervention, Windsurf lacks this feature
- OPPORTUNITY** Embed agent token consumption dashboard with smart optimization suggestions
- COMPETITORS** Claumon (prediction only), Windsurf (opaque)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

5. Ai review tools have security issues themselves • Heat 7/10

CodeRabbit found exploitable for malicious actions, afraid to use

- PAIN** Introducing AI review brings new risks, closed-source uneasy
- EXISTING** CodeRabbit, OpenCode Review both have security concerns
- OPPORTUNITY** Open-source, sandboxed review tool preventing arbitrary code execution
- COMPETITORS** CodeRabbit (security incidents), Sider (unstable)

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

6. Keep forgetting yesterday's design discussions while coding • Heat 6/10

Same project, Claude Code doesn't remember morning's architecture change

- PAIN** Repeated questions, agent repeats mistakes, no persistent memory
- EXISTING** AGENTS.md high maintenance, Claude Code sessions not persistent
- OPPORTUNITY** Project-level vector memory store, auto-summarize key decisions
- COMPETITORS** Mnemo (early stage), Cursor symbol memory too low-level

7. Ai agent wrecks system with shell commands • Heat 6/10

Giving agent shell access is like giving root, it uses sed to modify system files

- PAIN** No permission sandbox, no confirmation for high-risk ops, one mistake ruins everything
- EXISTING** Manually restrict workdir but agent always bypasses
- OPPORTUNITY** Built-in fine-grained permission sandbox with popup confirmation for high-risk ops
- COMPETITORS** None (existing agents require full trust)

AI Hardware

5 needs • sorted by heat

1. Apple devices Bluetooth drops frequently • Heat 7/10

iPhone loses connection to AirPods and Watch, missing notifications, requires restart

PAIN 1-2 disconnections per week, toggling airplane mode useless, embarrassing moments

EXISTING Restart phone temporarily fixes, no permanent solution

OPPORTUNITY Build Bluetooth diagnostic and auto-repair tool to restore without restart

COMPETITORS Apple has no such tool, Bluetooth Inspector only monitors

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

2. Smart home devices use separate apps • Heat 6/10

Developer installed BroadLink, I use Mi Home, switching between two apps

PAIN Turning off lights requires opening two apps, no cross-platform automation

EXISTING BroadLink doesn't support Mi Home, Home Assistant is too complex

OPPORTUNITY A hardware gateway with software bridge to auto-adapt various smart home protocols

COMPETITORS HomeAssistant (needs coding), Aqara (requires dedicated hub)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

3. Smart hardware becomes brick after discontinuation • Heat 5/10

Meta Portal abandoned, ADB open but flashing process is cumbersome

PAIN Big tech discontinuation turns hardware into e-waste, no user-friendly open-source firmware

EXISTING ADB unlock requires manual compilation, scattered documentation

OPPORTUNITY Unified flashing platform to install generic Android system with one click

COMPETITORS LineageOS (limited devices), PostmarketOS (early stage)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

4. No reliable IR accessory for iPhone • Heat 4/10

Android can control AC and TV via IR, iPhone lacks good accessories

PAIN Third-party IR dongles require app and are hard to use, no official solution

EXISTING Satechi has poor reviews, Broadlink needs extra hub

OPPORTUNITY Ultra-thin magnetic IR emitter with app, supporting HomeKit

COMPETITORS Satechi (unstable), Broadlink (needs hub)

For: Solo • Difficulty 2/5 • UP

5. Apple login spinner takes forever • Heat 4/10

Apple ID verification takes minutes, frequently loses login state

PAIN In-app authorization, iCloud sync, each time a long wait

EXISTING No alternative, just endure

OPPORTUNITY Local token caching and pre-login to avoid repeated authorization

6 needs • sorted by heat

1. Ai-written articles flood, hard to tell real • Heat 8/10

Find a good article, halfway realize it's AI-written, instantly lose interest

PAIN No reliable markers, readers overwhelmed by AI content, trust eroded

EXISTING GPTZero low accuracy, Turnitin only for academic

OPPORTUNITY Build browser extension + API for real-time AI content detection

COMPETITORS Originality.ai (writing-focused), Copyleaks (multilingual)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

2. Ai novel characters inconsistent personality • Heat 7/10

Ask AI to write continuous story, protagonist's personality changes by chapter 3, plot mismatches

PAIN AI lacks long-term memory, character settings can't persist across text

EXISTING Manual prompt constraints ineffective, no consistency tool

OPPORTUNITY Provide character cards + plot memory bank for consistent AI continuation

COMPETITORS Sudowrite (story engine but limited), NovelCrafter (requires templates)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

3. Ai video storyboards only text descriptions • Heat 6/10

Ask AI to generate short video script and storyboard, it only outputs text, not visuals

PAIN Still need to imagine shots, AI can't generate coherent storyboard panels

EXISTING DALL-E generates single images, can't maintain character consistency

OPPORTUNITY Generate animated previs + storyboard directly from script with consistent characters

COMPETITORS Runway (Pika not professional enough)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

4. Ai-generated images stolen, no recourse • Heat 6/10

Works created on AI platforms used commercially without permission, platform says can't help

- PAIN** Decentralized copyright registration missing, infringement cost too low
- EXISTING** Digimarc commercial copyright center, but process cumbersome
- OPPORTUNITY** Build on-chain copyright registration + automatic infringement detection AI
- COMPETITORS** Story Protocol (general), Verisart (art)

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

5. Subtitle translation mangles technical terms • Heat 5/10

API, CUDA, cache machine-translated incorrectly, need manual correction

- PAIN** Glossary can't be imported, same term translated inconsistently across contexts
- EXISTING** YouTube auto-translate, DeepL can't customize terminology
- OPPORTUNITY** AI translation allowing glossary upload for accurate technical terms
- COMPETITORS** SubtitleBee (expensive and inaccurate), MemoQ (complex)

6. Ai music generation lacks emotional dynamics • Heat 4/10

Ask AI to compose background music, melody flat like plain water, no emotional layers

- PAIN** Can't understand lyrics mood, generated rhythm and harmony monotonous
- EXISTING** Suno, Udio generate but lack editing capability
- OPPORTUNITY** AI composition tool with manual emotion tagging for dynamic control
- COMPETITORS** Suno (no fine-tuning), Stability Audio (short clips)

1. Find cheapest channel for desired product • Heat 6/10

Want Osprey backpack, prices differ on JD, Taobao, Hong Kong, plus 618 sales

PAIN Need to manually check multiple platforms, calculate exchange rates, tariffs, shipping; price comparison is hard

EXISTING Price comparison sites have outdated info; Manmanmai has limited coverage

OPPORTUNITY Cross-platform price comparison + historical price tracking, auto recommend best deal

COMPETITORS Keepa (Amazon only), Manmanmai (China only)

For: Solo • Difficulty 2/5 • UP

2. Messy spending records, don't know where money goes • Heat 6/10

WeChat, Alipay, bank cards, credit cards; monthly reconciliation is a headache

PAIN Rough categorization, no unified analysis, don't know which category overspent

EXISTING Budgeting apps require manual entry; bank apps are incomplete

OPPORTUNITY AI auto-reads SMS, emails, bills; gives personalized spending insights

COMPETITORS Mint shut down, YNAB manual, MoneyWiz all English

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

3. Travel planning takes days, still undecided • Heat 5/10

Want to go to Hong Kong/New Zealand; visa, flights, hotels, itinerary searched separately, info fragmented

PAIN Switching multiple apps, lack of one-stop AI assistant

EXISTING Ctrip only has flights/hotels; Xiaohongshu is fragmented

OPPORTUNITY Integrated visa reminders, flight/hotel comparison, AI itinerary generator

COMPETITORS TripIt (no AI), GuideGeek (English only)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

4. AI customer service only recites scripts, can't solve real problems • Heat 5/10

Call HVAC company, AI voice assistant gives irrelevant answers, no follow-up

PAIN Can't understand complex issues, long wait for human transfer

EXISTING Traditional IVR menus, AI agents like Zendesk are inflexible

OPPORTUNITY LLM-powered customer service agent that can query systems and transfer to human

COMPETITORS Zendesk AI (weak), Intercom Fin (limited)

Claimed discount coupons, never remember to use when ordering, regret after expiry

PAIN Coupons scattered across multiple apps, no unified expiry reminders

COMPETITORS Quanmama (aggregator), no smart tools available

PAIN Photos may be AI-generated, descriptions exaggerated, no verification mechanism

OPPORTUNITY AI listing authenticity detector, analyze consistency of photos, descriptions, data

PAIN Knowledge fragmented, no knowledge graph, can't identify gaps

COMPETITORS Anki (manual), RemNote (weak AI)

Using AI for English practice feels like a dictionary, no correction or feedback

PAIN No emotion or instant correction, can't simulate real scenarios

COMPETITORS ELSA Speak only pronunciation, italki expensive human tutors
