AI Tools

2 needs • sorted by heat

1. Duplicate files pile up, manual cleanup exhausting • Heat 1/10

Old to new PC, same-name files with different content stack up, manual search is tiring

PAIN Eye-scanning each folder, missing duplicates, accidentally deleting important files

EXISTING dupeGuru outdated UI, CCleaner slow scan, no smart preview or batch processing

OPPORTUNITY One-click scan with smart recommendations and preview comparison to avoid deletion errors

COMPETITORS dupeGuru not updated since 2016, Gemini 2.0 cannot handle local files

For: Solo • Difficulty 2/5 • UP

2. Want to learn new field but no knowledge map • Heat 1/10

Open browser to learn a new topic, don't know where to start, scattered resources

PAIN Each time learning a new field, manually gather papers, blogs, videos, time-consuming and may miss key literature

EXISTING Wikipedia entries orderly but shallow, Google Scholar keyword-based, lacking global view

OPPORTUNITY Just input topic, auto-generate knowledge topology map and core literature list, saving exploration time

COMPETITORS Connected Papers limited to papers, Litmaps requires manual maintenance

// AI DEVELOPMENT

AI Development

6 needs • sorted by heat

1. Ai writes hundreds of lines, review is more tiring than writing • Heat 8/10

Ai generates thousands of lines, fixing one bug introduces three new ones, review is overwhelming

PAIN Each review requires understanding Ai's intent line by line, changes span multiple files, cannot verify quickly

EXISTING Copilot doesn't explain changes, Cursor lacks formatted review assistance in chat

OPPORTUNITY If Ai attaches change reasons and impact analysis when generating code, review burden drops significantly

COMPETITORS CodeRabbit offers simple review but insufficient explanation, GitHub Copilot lacks this feature

2. Commercial apis too expensive and dependent, want local free models • Heat 7/10

Developers resent paid apis and dependencies, want local models for equivalent coding tasks

PAIN Cannot work after quota exhausted, data leakage risk, costs rise linearly with usage

EXISTING LM Studio Bionic is nascent, Ollama lacks agent capability

OPPORTUNITY Running near-commercial coding agents on consumer hardware can capture many developers

COMPETITORS HuggingFace has many models but no agents, Ollama weak, LM Studio early

3. Same bug fixed three times by ai, each time starting from scratch • Heat 6/10

Coding agent repeatedly searches for same issue, previous fix experience cannot be reused

PAIN Each new session forgets history, wastes many tokens, debugging efficiency very low

EXISTING Deja provides indexing but requires manual trigger, analysis not automated enough

OPPORTUNITY Auto-save context, directly reference past solutions for similar issues, can reduce token consumption by 60%

COMPETITORS Codex has no memory, Deja only stores text without semantic matching

4. Ai cli scans entire home directory on first run, scary • Heat 5/10

Running ai command, it automatically reads and uploads all files, user unaware and without control

- PAIN** Don't know which data is accessed, cannot restrict access scope, sensitive files risk leakage
- EXISTING** Most cli tools lack permission config, only manual directory changes; sandbox isolation not widespread
- OPPORTUNITY** Ask for required paths at startup and enforce sandbox isolation, users can use with confidence
- COMPETITORS** Claude Code has config but crude, Grok Cli has no permission management

5. Ai-written code, help reviewer understand what changed • Heat 4/10

Ai-generated pull request lacks design intent, reviewer struggles to judge change impact

- PAIN** Reviewer must guess Ai intent, comparing multiple files is time-consuming, easy to miss hidden issues
- EXISTING** Traditional pr review has no ai explanation; GitHub's Copilot review only detects errors
- OPPORTUNITY** Ai generates natural language explanation and impact analysis for each change, improving review efficiency
- COMPETITORS** CodeRabbit has simple explanation not deep enough, GitHub itself lacks

6. Multiple ai agents collaborate, get stuck in infinite loops • Heat 3/10

Multi-agent systems without feedback loops require frequent manual intervention to reset

- PAIN** Max_iterations parameter hard to tune, too large or too small both problematic, debugging tools scarce
- EXISTING** LoopGain uses control theory but not widespread, LangChain's agent executor is very basic
- OPPORTUNITY** Auto-detect loop patterns and dynamically adjust feedback, stabilizing multi-agent systems
- COMPETITORS** LoopGain is the only open-source library targeting this, not commercially mature

// AI HARDWARE

AI Hardware

3 needs • sorted by heat

1. Usb-c charger cable chaos • Heat 5/10

Multiple chargers and cables at home, mixing leads to slow or no charging

PAIN Uncertain which cable supports PD or only 5V, trial and error with different devices

EXISTING Charging testers like Power-Z can measure, but not for average users; manufacturer specs hard to find

OPPORTUNITY Design a cable that auto-detects all protocols and clearly labels support, eliminating confusion

COMPETITORS Anker has multi-protocol chargers but no unified cable labeling; USB-IF standard progress slow

2. Smartwatch daily charging fatigue • Heat 4/10

Tired of daily charging and excessive features, want ultra-long battery with core functions

PAIN Daily charging hassle, notification overload, unused extra features

EXISTING Withings ScanWatch long battery but limited features, Garmin sports-oriented, Pebble discontinued

OPPORTUNITY Offer two-week battery plus basic health monitoring and limited notifications to attract the overwhelmed

COMPETITORS Withings ScanWatch exists but pricey, Amazfit long battery but rough system

3. Beta update wiped all phone data • Heat 3/10

Auto-upgraded to beta, phone bricked and data lost after recovery

PAIN No clear recovery option, store mishandling leads to permanent loss of photos and chats

EXISTING iCloud backup not default, local backup requires computer and many don't know how

OPPORTUNITY Force full backup and verification before beta upgrade, provide one-click restore channel

COMPETITORS Apple native recovery mode has flaws, Google also loses data in beta

AI Content

4 needs • sorted by heat

1. Can't Edit a Single Frame in AI Video • Heat 6/10

AI-generated music video has a bad frame, but can't fine-tune it

- PAIN** Generative video lacks layers and keyframe editing; must regenerate
- EXISTING** Runway has temporal editing but limited; Adobe Premiere doesn't support AI-native editing
- OPPORTUNITY** Save editable layers and keyframes in AI video, enabling traditional-like adjustments
- COMPETITORS** Runway, Pika lack fine editing; CapCut is weak

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 5/5 • UP

2. Bought Digital Movies Can Disappear • Heat 4/10

Digital movies purchased on Sony etc. removed due to service changes, no user control

- PAIN** Purchased digital content is actually rented; platform can remove anytime, no permanent access
- EXISTING** DRM-free digital copies rare; physical discs inconvenient; Kaleidescape expensive
- OPPORTUNITY** Offer DRM-free local copies or permanent licenses to eliminate distrust
- COMPETITORS** Vudu, iTunes don't offer permanent downloads; Kaleidescape very pricey

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

3. Spotify Keeps Recommending Same Songs • Heat 3/10

Algorithmic recommendations are homogeneous; users crave niche and unexpected music

- PAIN** Repeated similar tracks; escaping comfort zone requires manual effort, inefficient
- EXISTING** Last.fm good but stagnating; RateYourMusic requires manual ratings
- OPPORTUNITY** Graph-based listening algorithm recommends low-relevance surprises to satisfy exploration
- COMPETITORS** Spotify's Discover Weekly is conservative; Apple Music lacks novelty

4. Built Product, No Time for Marketing • Heat 2/10

Indie developers finish product but lack time and budget for ongoing content marketing

PAIN Manual copywriting, image creation, social posting; unsustainable and eats dev time

EXISTING Buffer, Hootsuite schedule posts but can't auto-generate creative content

OPPORTUNITY Input product assets, auto-generate multi-platform posts/videos and schedule distribution

COMPETITORS Canva strong in design but no auto-scheduling; new AI agents like Textify are single-function

AI Lifestyle

3 needs • sorted by heat

1. Museum audio guide on demand • Heat 2/10

Visitors want exhibit stories but find human guides costly and text labels disruptive

PAIN Renting audio guides is expensive and queues; scanning codes breaks immersion

EXISTING Museum apps have limited coverage; Google Lens lacks storytelling

OPPORTUNITY Snap a photo and get AI-generated personalized audio commentary instantly

COMPETITORS Smartify only scans famous works; Impression AI has weak features

2. Smart tab manager for browsers • Heat 2/10

Users open dozens of tabs daily but struggle to find the right one quickly

PAIN Manual organization is time-consuming; closing risks forgetting; tools either auto-close or list without context

EXISTING OneTab saves without categorization; Tab Wrangler auto-closes but no preview

OPPORTUNITY Auto-group and prioritize tabs, allow suspend/resume and search

COMPETITORS Microsoft Edge tab groups are not smart enough; OneTab is feature-limited

3. Trusted second-hand phone inspection • Heat 1/10

Buyers worry about hidden defects when meeting sellers in person for used phones

PAIN On-site inspection is brief; issues discovered later are denied by sellers

EXISTING Xianyu Inspection covers limited categories; Apple trade-in offers low prices

OPPORTUNITY Third-party remote video inspection with escrow payment reduces risk

COMPETITORS Xianyu Inspection has narrow coverage; Zhuanzhuan inspection fees are high

// AI EDUCATION

AI Education

3 needs • sorted by heat

1. Detect ai-written student assignments • Heat 4/10

Teachers struggle to identify AI-generated homework; traditional plagiarism checkers fail.

PAIN Detection tools have low accuracy; students can rewrite to bypass; writing process untrackable.

EXISTING GPTZero, Originality.ai static detection easily bypassed.

OPPORTUNITY Improve accuracy using writing process data (e.g., keystrokes) and pattern analysis.

COMPETITORS Turnitin new features imperfect; GPTZero limited accuracy.

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

2. Learn lisp with interactive visuals • Heat 3/10

Learning complex programming concepts lacks intuitive interactive demos.

PAIN Text-heavy materials, passive videos; no hands-on experiments or internal state observation.

EXISTING Visualgo.net has data structure animations but no compiler tools.

OPPORTUNITY Turn abstract concepts into interactive animations and sandboxes, lowering learning curve.

COMPETITORS Visualgo.net covers algorithms only; SICP lacks interactive tools.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • STABLE

3. Personalized rust learning path • Heat 2/10

Developers overwhelmed by abundant resources, can't plan optimal learning sequence.

PAIN Self-planning risks missing topics or wrong order, causing frustration and dropout.

EXISTING Roadmap.sh provides generic paths; LLM recommendations unreliable.

OPPORTUNITY Adaptively generate unique learning paths based on user's existing skills and goals.

COMPETITORS Pluralsight fixed paths after assessment; Codecademy only default order.

// AI HEALTH

AI Health

2 needs • sorted by heat

1. Want to work out but no coach, online plans unreliable • Heat 2/10

Users want to start fitness and diet, but personal trainers are expensive and online plans don't fit.

- PAIN** Online info is mixed, blind following leads to injury, no dynamic plan tailored to individual.
- EXISTING** Keep and Fitbod have plans but no diet integration; MyFitnessPal has diet but no training.
- OPPORTUNITY** Dynamically generate training and diet calendar based on user body data, goals, and equipment.
- COMPETITORS** Fitbod customizable but no diet, MyFitnessPal no training, Aaptiv no correction.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

2. Feeling down but don't want to see therapist, want self-record relief • Heat 1/10

Users have depression or anxiety but avoid direct medical help, want self-management first.

- PAIN** Traditional diary apps too simple without guidance, professional therapy apps have long wait times.
- EXISTING** Woebot offers CBT but rigid structure, Daylio only mood tracking.
- OPPORTUNITY** Combine mood tracking, cognitive distortion recognition, and instant soothing exercises for low-cost improvement.
- COMPETITORS** Woebot chatbot but limited interaction, Headspace no cognitive behavioral therapy.

// BIG PICTURE

Big Company View (Enterprise)

Directions that need strategic synergy, scale and brand — beyond what solo or small teams can pursue.

1. Commercial apis too expensive and dependent, want local free models • Heat 7/10 • AI Development

Developers resent paid apis and dependencies, want local models for equivalent coding tasks

STRATEGIC Seize open-source Ai infrastructure, bind developer toolchain, reduce external api dependency

INCUMBENTS HuggingFace provides models without agents; Ollama simple; LM Studio startup

TIMING Commercial model price hikes plus privacy concerns, local hardware improving, open-source models approaching frontier

2. Can't Edit a Single Frame in AI Video • Heat 6/10 • AI Content

AI-generated music video has a bad frame, but can't fine-tune it

STRATEGIC Own next-gen video creation infrastructure, lock in creators and fans

INCUMBENTS Adobe dominates traditional editing but weak in AI; Runway is a startup

TIMING AI video quality is usable; editing is the last gap; early entry

3. Usb-c charger cable chaos • Heat 5/10 • AI Hardware

Multiple chargers and cables at home, mixing leads to slow or no charging

STRATEGIC Dominate charging experience standard, boost brand loyalty, drive accessory ecosystem

INCUMBENTS Apple with proprietary protocols, Anker third-party incomplete, Belkin mediocre

TIMING Market chaotic for years, users frustrated, USB-IF slow to act

4. Bought Digital Movies Can Disappear • Heat 4/10 • AI Content

Digital movies purchased on Sony etc. removed due to service changes, no user control

STRATEGIC Break trust barrier in digital consumption, build sustainable distribution model

INCUMBENTS Sony, Warner dominate distribution but reluctant to give up control

TIMING User awareness of digital ownership growing; EU legal trends support

5. Detect ai-written student assignments • Heat 4/10 • AI Education

Teachers struggle to identify AI-generated homework; traditional plagiarism checkers fail.

STRATEGIC Educational necessity, global market, but tech arms race continues.

INCUMBENTS Turnitin strong brand but outdated tech; GPTZero startup.

TIMING AI homework prevalence surges demand; existing solutions inadequate.

6. Beta update wiped all phone data • Heat 3/10 • AI Hardware

Auto-upgraded to beta, phone bricked and data lost after recovery

STRATEGIC Enhance update safety perception, reduce support costs, strengthen brand trust

INCUMBENTS Apple and Google both fail to perfectly solve beta data loss

TIMING More users joining beta testing, data loss incidents frequent with public pressure
