AI Tools

9 needs • sorted by heat

1. Ai search assistant needs clean api • Heat 7/10

Search results for agents are full of ads and noise, willing to pay for clean data

PAIN Willing to pay for search but Kagi lacks MCP interface, self-built is inefficient

EXISTING Generic search APIs have messy results and ads, not optimized for agents

OPPORTUNITY Build a high-quality, ad-free MCP search service with per-call pricing

COMPETITORS Kagi (no MCP), Google/Bing API (ads heavy)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

2. Can't swap words without retranslating • Heat 6/10

After translating a paragraph, can't replace a single word without redoing the whole thing

PAIN Every synonym change requires deleting and retranslating, or switching to a dictionary, very disruptive

EXISTING Only DeepL supports word-level replacement, others don't

OPPORTUNITY Allow clicking any word in translation to show alternatives and auto-adjust context

COMPETITORS DeepL (already has it), Google Translate, Microsoft Translator (none)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

3. Ai agent to filter clean content • Heat 6/10

Articles full of ads, paywalls, popups; personal agent should skip them

PAIN Manually close popups and wait through ads on every site; wish an agent could handle it

EXISTING Adblock blocks ads but not paywalls, can't extract main content

OPPORTUNITY Build a browser or local AI agent that automatically extracts article body

COMPETITORS 1Blocker, uBlock Origin (ads only)

4. Ai memory remembers wrong things • Heat 6/10

Claude's auto memory treats irrelevant details as important, causing off-topic replies

- PAIN** Smart memory makes wrong assumptions, and I can't see how it decides
- EXISTING** Claude automemory, manual memory file maintenance
- OPPORTUNITY** Create transparent, editable AI memory management tool for user control
- COMPETITORS** No dedicated memory management product

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

5. Too many separate ai tool subscriptions • Heat 5/10

Claude Code, Codex, ChatGPT each charge separately, tokens not shared

- PAIN** Already paying for LLMs, why pay again for each tool?
- EXISTING** Only individual subscriptions, no unified account or billing
- OPPORTUNITY** Build a middleware that unifies LLM API calls with usage-based pricing
- COMPETITORS** OpenRouter (API proxy, no desktop tool integration)

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

6. App keeps asking to upgrade • Heat 5/10

Open an app and get update prompts and feature tours instead of getting work done

- PAIN** Third time using the app and already harassed; will uninstall if it continues
- EXISTING** In-app notification options, but many popups can't be disabled
- OPPORTUNITY** Develop browser/system-level tool to auto-block in-app upgrade popups
- COMPETITORS** Some browsers have reading mode but don't actively block

For: Solo • Difficulty 2/5 • STABLE

7. Deploying service requires reading long docs • Heat 5/10

Just want to run code, not learn Docker, K8s, server config

- PAIN** Every deployment needs extensive documentation, cognitive load too high
- EXISTING** Fly.io, Railway still require significant configuration
- OPPORTUNITY** Build an end-to-end tool that deploys from a one-sentence description
- COMPETITORS** Vercel (frontend only), Fly.io (still complex)

8. Api docs need manual translation for ai • Heat 4/10

OpenAPI JSON models aren't readable by AI; must manually write prompts

PAIN Maintaining AI-readable API docs is harder than coding, and updates are forgotten

EXISTING Handwrite Claude.md, Agents.md to describe

OPPORTUNITY Auto-generate structured prompts from API docs with version sync

COMPETITORS Vercel has related articles but no product

9. Bookmark should open in specific container • Heat 4/10

Firefox has containers but bookmarks don't remember which container to use

PAIN Every bookmark click requires right-click and container selection, extra step

EXISTING Multi-Account Containers extension (manual setup needed)

OPPORTUNITY Browser natively supports bookmark-container binding, one-click open

COMPETITORS Firefox doesn't support natively, extension experience subpar

// AI DEVELOPMENT

AI Development

9 needs • sorted by heat

1. CLI tools output fancy text, grep fails • Heat 5/10

Installed a CLI, but output has tables and animations, can't filter with grep.

PAIN Can't use grep/awk because output is special format, completely unusable.

EXISTING Some tools offer --plain option, but not universal.

OPPORTUNITY Default to plain parseable format (e.g., JSON) while keeping interactivity.

COMPETITORS Most TUI CLI tools don't focus on parsability.

For: Solo • Difficulty 2/5 • STABLE

2. CLI needs separate window for GUI • Heat 5/10

Using Kimi to code, previewing files requires leaving terminal to open browser.

PAIN CLI and Web UI are separate, inefficient, unlike Claude Code Desktop.

EXISTING Some tools have standalone Web UI, but not in same window.

OPPORTUNITY Embed lightweight Web UI inside CLI process for real-time interaction.

COMPETITORS Claude Code Desktop (exists), other CLIs lack this.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

3. AI agent needs safe compression for long output • Heat 4/10

AI runs command with thousands of lines, truncation misses errors.

PAIN Simple truncation or summary drops critical error info, causing issues.

EXISTING Sqr (new open-source tool, but limited).

OPPORTUNITY Build smart compression that preserves error lines and references, shortens rest.

COMPETITORS Sqr (early stage).

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

4. AI verbose, need structured data directly • Heat 4/10

Request array result, AI gives natural language explanation, manual parsing needed.

- PAIN** In automation, conversational output unusable without post-processing.
- EXISTING** System prompt for structured output, but models often disobey.
- OPPORTUNITY** Design tool to auto-convert AI output to JSON/table regardless of model response.
- COMPETITORS** No dedicated conversion layer.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

5. Local open-source models far behind Cursor • Heat 4/10

Company provides free model, code quality worse than Cursor Pro auto mode.

- PAIN** Free but inaccurate completions, poor context understanding, requires rework.
- EXISTING** Cursor, Copilot (cloud subscription, better).
- OPPORTUNITY** Optimize local model code completion or combine with LoRA fine-tuning.
- COMPETITORS** Cursor Pro, Codex (cloud), LocalAI (weak).

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

6. Tutorial selling blocked by platform barriers • Heat 4/10

Want to sell paid column, but Xiaobao Tong requires 3000 followers, Juejin L5 level.

- PAIN** Have content but no followers, can't monetize, stuck.
- EXISTING** Xiaobao Tong, Juejin, Zhihu column (all have follower thresholds).
- OPPORTUNITY** Build knowledge payment platform independent of follower count, support docs+courses.
- COMPETITORS** Xiaobao Tong, Juejin (high barriers).

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

7. pip downloads no hash check, tamper risk • Heat 4/10

npm auto-verifies integrity, Python requires manual checksum.

- PAIN** After pip install, must manually checksum; forget and it's unsafe.
- EXISTING** PyPI doesn't provide default verification, all manual.
- OPPORTUNITY** Implement auto-verification in pip or provide one-click verification plugin.
- COMPETITORS** None.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • STABLE

8. Forum content only searchable manually, AI can't access • Heat 3/10

Search historical discussions in forum, need to type keywords, agent can't do it.

- PAIN** Public forums have lots of knowledge, but AI agents lack standard interface.
- EXISTING** Reddit API (restricted), HN API (basic only).
- OPPORTUNITY** Enable forums to provide MCP service, allowing AI agents to retrieve/operate with permissions.
- COMPETITORS** No MCP standard support.

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

9. Paid Claude and Codex still risk account ban • Heat 3/10

Personal subscriptions to Claude and Codex often face bans, payment failures.

- PAIN** Worried about ban, refund issues, poor experience, no reliable channel.
- EXISTING** Top-up services, gift cards (unreliable, risky).
- OPPORTUNITY** Provide compliant, stable personal subscription service with multiple payment methods.
- COMPETITORS** No reliable intermediary.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • STABLE

AI Hardware

3 needs • sorted by heat

1. Auto color temperature light switch • Heat 5/10

Home light switch cycles colors manually, can't auto-switch by time

PAIN Must press three times to get desired color; voice control unreliable

EXISTING Standard smart switches only on/off, no color sequence support

OPPORTUNITY Build smart switch with time-based color rules or Home Assistant integration

COMPETITORS Philips Hue, Xiaomi Smart Light (require hub/complex setup)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

2. iPhone SMS sync to Windows • Heat 4/10

Receive verification codes on PC but need to check phone

PAIN Always grab phone for codes; poor phone-PC collaboration

EXISTING Pushbullet (paid/unstable), Microsoft Phone Link (limited features)

OPPORTUNITY Create lightweight open-source iOS SMS forwarder for Windows with auto-copy

COMPETITORS Pushbullet, Microsoft Phone Link

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

3. Free reliable NTFS write on Mac • Heat 3/10

Mac can't write to NTFS drives without paid or risky free solutions

PAIN Free options unstable or require disabling SIP; paid ones expensive

EXISTING BuhoNTFS, Paragon NTFS (paid), Mounity (requires SIP off)

OPPORTUNITY Develop open-source stable NTFS driver without SIP disable

COMPETITORS BuhoNTFS, Paragon (both paid)

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • STABLE

AI Education

1 needs • sorted by heat

1. Convert math formulas to code • Heat 3/10

Instantly turn paper formulas into executable code

PAIN Knowing algorithm logic but spending hours translating to code with errors

EXISTING Manual coding or MathML conversion, neither direct

OPPORTUNITY Auto-generate code (Python/JS) from formula screenshots or text

COMPETITORS Mathpix (recognizes formulas only, no code generation)

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

// BIG PICTURE

Big Company View (Enterprise)

Directions that need strategic synergy, scale and brand — beyond what solo or small teams can pursue.

1. Too many separate ai tool subscriptions • Heat 5/10 • AI Tools

Claude Code, Codex, ChatGPT each charge separately, tokens not shared

STRATEGIC Integrate multiple models, create AI app store, lock in developer ecosystem

INCUMBENTS OpenRouter, Poe (distribution only, no token unification)

TIMING LLM tools exploding, users frustrated with fragmented payments

2. Bookmark should open in specific container • Heat 4/10 • AI Tools

Firefox has containers but bookmarks don't remember which container to use

STRATEGIC Boost browser competitiveness, attract privacy users

INCUMBENTS Firefox (not native), Chrome (no containers)

TIMING Firefox already testing container management, bookmark binding is natural next step

3. Local open-source models far behind Cursor • Heat 4/10 • AI Development

Company provides free model, code quality worse than Cursor Pro auto mode.

STRATEGIC Enter open-source model ecosystem, offer free but usable coding experience.

INCUMBENTS Cursor, GitHub Copilot (cloud-dependent), LocalAI (weak).

TIMING Open-source models improving fast; slight experience gap can attract many users.
