AI Tools

2 needs • sorted by heat

1. AI Chat Tab Overload • Heat 7/10

Multiple AI windows open, each with different tasks; switching loses context.

PAIN Each session has isolated context; too many tasks cause confusion, relying on memory.

EXISTING Browser bookmarks and tabs; AI clients lack task grouping.

OPPORTUNITY Auto-group sessions by project or task for instant context on switch.

COMPETITORS ChatGPT and Claude desktop only list sessions, no cross-session task view.

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

2. Cannot Edit Conversation Context • Heat 6/10

A stray comment in chat gets latched onto; no way to remove it alone.

PAIN To make AI forget a sentence, must start new chat and re-feed all context.

EXISTING Models only clear entire session; no partial context editing.

OPPORTUNITY Select and delete a context segment like an editor, continue chat seamlessly.

COMPETITORS ThoughtDAG offers DAG editing but as standalone app, not integrated.

AI Development

10 needs • sorted by heat

1. Claude Code Runs Blind, Changes Unknown • Heat 8/10

Days later, reviewing jsonl fails to reveal decision process

PAIN Tracing agent decisions takes an afternoon; jsonl is unreadable

EXISTING Claude Code /resume continues chat, lacks decision timeline

OPPORTUNITY Visualize tool calls and file edits as replayable timeline

COMPETITORS OpenCode, Claude Code sessions are raw logs

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

2. AI Silently Assumes, Discovered After Commits • Heat 7/10

Unclear requirements lead agent to assume and proceed

PAIN Wrong assumptions require rollback, wasting three days

EXISTING Aakit detects assumptions but only reports, no intervention

OPPORTUNITY Interrupt agent on assumptions to reduce rework

COMPETITORS Aakit is only one, but detection-only

3. AI Generates 2000-Line PR, Reviewers Overwhelmed • Heat 7/10

Agent struggles to break work into small commits

PAIN Large PRs unreviewable; small PRs hit context limits

EXISTING GitHub Copilot reviews single files, not commit granularity

OPPORTUNITY Plan dependency graph first, auto-split into reviewable steps

COMPETITORS Claude Code, Codex lack task serialization

4. MCP Multi-Step Calls Resend Context Each Handoff • Heat 7/10

Real tasks with many steps consume five times tokens

- PAIN** Each step returns results to model, causing repeated re-entry
- EXISTING** MCP protocol lacks state passing; agents are siloed
- OPPORTUNITY** Variable passing replaces model re-entry, saving ~80% tokens
- COMPETITORS** Tura Direct saves 78% but not widespread

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • NEW

5. Full Permissions for AI Agents, Who's Liable? • Heat 6/10

Want agents to run tests and edit files, fear environment damage

- PAIN** Reconfiguring permissions per tool is painful, tight or loose
- EXISTING** Docker sandboxes need custom scripts, snapshot restore is messy
- OPPORTUNITY** One-click isolated environment, auto-destroy on session end
- COMPETITORS** Docker, Incus are generic, not agent-designed

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

6. AI Agent Black Box, Hard to Debug Issues • Heat 6/10

Tool calls, thoughts, file edits scattered, no replay

- PAIN** Agent errors require full session rerun, wasting tokens
- EXISTING** Verbose mode outputs raw logs, unreadable
- OPPORTUNITY** Serialize thought-action-edit into visual timeline
- COMPETITORS** OpenCode shows thinking trace but doesn't save structure

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

7. AI Code Looks Fine, But Fails in Practice • Heat 6/10

Agent writes tests only for its own happy path

- PAIN** Manual review costs near rewriting; automated tests miss edge cases
- EXISTING** Copilot auto-generates unit tests with variable quality
- OPPORTUNITY** Use mutation testing for adversarial cases to catch blind spots
- COMPETITORS** Cursor, Copilot lack adversarial validation

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

8. AI Searches Files Across Project, Ignoring Index • Heat 5/10

On Windows, agent recursively scans whole project for files

- PAIN** Large projects take seconds per search; existing Everything index unused
- EXISTING** Everything has es.exe but agents don't call it
- OPPORTUNITY** Integrate system-level index into agent toolchain
- COMPETITORS** ripgrep is default but does full scans each time

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • NEW

9. Want Another AI to Critique, Manual Copy-Paste • Heat 5/10

In Claude, asking Codex to review requires new window

- PAIN** Models have blind spots; cross-validation is manual
- EXISTING** Prompting other CLIs lacks shared context
- OPPORTUNITY** Auto-route to multiple models for adversarial review in one session
- COMPETITORS** CLIs are single-model, no native multi-model collaboration

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

10. Local 27B Model Slow Without MTP, Unusable • Heat 5/10

RTX 3090 gets 30 tok/s without MTP; manual session doubles it

- PAIN** Local models save API costs but are slow; setup deters users
- EXISTING** llama.cpp supports but manual params; Qwen not proactive
- OPPORTUNITY** One-click speculative sampling doubles local inference speed
- COMPETITORS** llama.cpp, vLLM support MTP but high config barrier

AI Hardware

2 needs • sorted by heat

1. E-ink News Reader to Curb Phone Overuse • Heat 7/10

RSS to e-ink newspaper, daily curated push

PAIN Phone feeds scattered, addictive; e-ink devices hard to customize

EXISTING Xteink requires coding, Kindle lacks RSS support

OPPORTUNITY Out-of-box e-ink news terminal with auto layout for focused reading

COMPETITORS Xteink is DIY, Remarkable lacks news subscriptions

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

2. Compact AI Inference Box for Office Prototyping • Heat 6/10

Run models at work without bulky desktop setup

PAIN Remote connections unstable, company denies personal GPUs, local deployment complex

EXISTING Cloud GPUs cost money, IT blocks personal devices

OPPORTUNITY Small, silent, plug-and-play AI box with built-in model management

COMPETITORS NVIDIA Jetson embedded-focused, Mac Studio pricey and niche

AI Content

5 needs • sorted by heat

1. AI Writing All Sounds the Same • Heat 7/10

Every AI article follows the same template, instantly recognizable

PAIN Creators using AI spend more time removing AI tone than writing

EXISTING Models lack style parameters; prompt tuning has limits

OPPORTUNITY Let AI learn user's writing style to produce human-like output

COMPETITORS OpenAI, Anthropic have fixed styles, no personalization

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

2. Human Writing Mistaken for AI • Heat 6/10

AI content flood makes original human work suspect as machine-made

PAIN False positives from AI detectors; no trusted way to prove authorship

EXISTING C2PA needs platform support; Glaze only protects visual art

OPPORTUNITY Provide creators a credible human authorship verification process

COMPETITORS C2PA not widespread; detectors have high false positive rates

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 5/5 • UP

3. No Age-Appropriate News Podcasts for Kids • Heat 5/10

8-year-olds curious about world, but news is too fast or violent

PAIN Parents lack time to explain news daily; few kids' news options

EXISTING MyFirst.News is a personal experiment, unstable

OPPORTUNITY Auto-generate safe, fun, age-tiered news daily

COMPETITORS BBC kids' news updates slowly; MyFirst.News is DIY

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • NEW

4. AI Long Stories Collapse After Ten Minutes • Heat 5/10

Long-form content like short dramas and kids' shows loses coherence

PAIN Character consistency fails; plot holes appear in long arcs

EXISTING Models lose focus; no architecture for long stories

OPPORTUNITY Outline plot and character cards first, generate scene-by-scene for consistency

COMPETITORS Sudowrite focuses on short; Claude, OpenAI lack long-story mode

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

5. Video Course Creation Too Hard for Experts • Heat 4/10

Want to turn knowledge into courses, but lack equipment, team, time

PAIN Recording needs studio, lighting, editing; AI courses risk low quality

EXISTING Keet generates videos but shallow; big players may copy

OPPORTUNITY Focus on niches like corporate training; human experts ensure quality

COMPETITORS Keet is YC project with shallow moat; Synthesia only does avatars

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • STABLE

AI Lifestyle

3 needs • sorted by heat

1. Global Payment Outage Status • Heat 6/10

Mastercard down, banks clueless, customers stuck waiting in stores.

PAIN Card declines unclear if card or system issue, no way to verify.

EXISTING Bank apps only report own issues, Downdetector data lags.

OPPORTUNITY Aggregate payment channel health, check before swiping.

COMPETITORS Downdetector broad but not real-time, bank support slow.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 3/5 • NEW

2. Xianyu Court Evidence Chaos • Heat 6/10

Buyer claims USB lost or damaged, seller insists it was fine.

PAIN Both sides argue, no automated evidence chain analysis.

EXISTING Xianyu court relies on manual voting, support inefficient.

OPPORTUNITY Auto-organize chat, logistics, image metadata into timeline.

COMPETITORS Xianyu lacks this, other platforms manual too.

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

3. Gift Giving Guesswork • Heat 5/10

Valentine's gift for girlfriend, speakers and bags done, no ideas.

PAIN Scrolling Xiaohongshu and Taobao, still unsure, fear wasting money.

EXISTING Xiaohongshu ads, Taobao recommendations too broad.

OPPORTUNITY Recommend specific gifts based on recipient profile and history.

COMPETITORS Giftagram sparse data, big platforms lack personalization.

AI Education

6 needs • sorted by heat

1. Learn New Fields with Non-Linear AI • Heat 7/10

Start from cryptography and dive deeper, but AI only gives one paragraph at a time.

PAIN Context gets lost when asking deeper questions; no knowledge map to drill into.

EXISTING ChatGPT conversations are linear; mind mapping tools don't integrate with LLMs.

OPPORTUNITY Turn subject knowledge into a drillable tree, mapping as you learn.

COMPETITORS Notion AI summarizes but doesn't explore; AI learning tools are Q&A based.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

2. AI Answers Without Adjusting to My Level • Heat 6/10

Ask a question and get all background info; simple questions take three minutes to read.

PAIN Want AI to explain at my level, but it defaults to the most complete version.

EXISTING Writing 'explain simply' in prompts works but is inconsistent.

OPPORTUNITY Automatically assess user expertise and adjust explanation depth dynamically.

COMPETITORS Perplexity has concise mode but doesn't proactively adapt to the reader.

For: Small Team • Difficulty 4/5 • UP

3. Learn Java Concurrency with Hands-On Lessons • Heat 5/10

Twenty interactive mini-lessons from threads to thread pools beat watching tutorials.

PAIN Learning is fragmented; tutorials are either too abstract or too verbose.

EXISTING Teach skill is a command-line tool, not user-friendly for non-techies.

OPPORTUNITY Break skills into interactive hands-on lessons that you can apply immediately.

COMPETITORS DataCamp has courses but not personalized; Duolingo is only for languages.

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

4. Learn Languages by Reading Adapted News • Heat 5/10

Push Spanish news to Kindle daily; consistent reading boosts proficiency.

PAIN Graded readers update slowly; real news is too hard; bilingual comparison is cumbersome.

EXISTING Calibre only converts formats, can't adjust difficulty.

OPPORTUNITY Rewrite real-time news to match language level and push automatically daily.

COMPETITORS Readlang requires manual adding; News in Levels covers few languages.

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • UP

5. Master C Pointers with Visual Memory Models • Heat 4/10

Know Python but C pointers are a struggle; need intuitive understanding.

PAIN Textbooks are text-only; lack interactive memory model demonstrations.

EXISTING Python Tutor doesn't cover C; GDB is too complex for beginners.

OPPORTUNITY Interactive memory visualization with real-time AI explanations.

COMPETITORS Python Tutor doesn't support C pointers; debuggers are too hardcore.

6. Learn Math as a Programmer, Not a Linguist • Heat 4/10

Programmers get stuck on math syntax; need conceptual guidance.

PAIN Programmers take detours learning math; lack teaching methods tailored to them.

EXISTING 3B1B videos are cool but one-way; traditional textbooks don't understand programmers.

OPPORTUNITY Translate math concepts using programmer-friendly language.

COMPETITORS 3Blue1Brown lacks interactivity; Brilliant targets general audience.

AI Health

3 needs • sorted by heat

1. Aching in Rainy Weather • Heat 5/10

No illness but aches and fatigue, suspect lack of sunlight.

PAIN No tool links weather, pressure, sunlight to symptoms.

EXISTING Apple Health tracks data, not causes; weather apps ignore health.

OPPORTUNITY Combine weather and personal health data to analyze impact.

COMPETITORS Clue links weather to cycles; no general health analysis.

For: Solo • Difficulty 3/5 • NEW

2. Fitness Diet Assistant • Heat 4/10

Zero-fat yogurt with oats is good, but daily gets boring.

PAIN Fitness folks need high-protein low-fat plans; nutritionists costly.

EXISTING MyFitnessPal counts calories; Mint Health's food database outdated.

OPPORTUNITY Recommend recipes based on training goals and pantry inventory.

COMPETITORS MyFitnessPal has data but no smarts; domestic apps ad-heavy.

For: Solo • Difficulty 2/5 • STABLE

3. Phone Before Bed Causes Dreams • Heat 3/10

High-stimulation content harms sleep; need alternatives.

PAIN Know should reduce but can't resist; need external intervention.

EXISTING iOS Screen Time can be bypassed; Forest only treats symptoms.

OPPORTUNITY Auto-switch to low-stimulation mode before bed; AI recommends sleep aids.

COMPETITORS Apple Screen Time too easy to bypass; sleep trackers only monitor.

2 needs • sorted by heat

1. AI Judge Prompt Injection in Court • Heat 4/10

Legal documents contain prompts to manipulate AI-assisted rulings.

PAIN Courts use AI without disclosure or anti-manipulation safeguards.

EXISTING No audit trail standards exist for judicial AI.

OPPORTUNITY Provide auditable decision chains and input validation for judicial AI.

COMPETITORS LexisNexis AI only does legal research, not judicial process.

For: Enterprise • Difficulty 5/5 • NEW

2. AI-Generated Game Content Trust Crisis • Heat 4/10

Game art and design show AI traces, eroding player trust.

PAIN Indie games use AI assets, making human effort unclear.

EXISTING Steam requires disclosure but lacks enforcement and tiers.

OPPORTUNITY Create AI content disclosure standards for games, giving choice.

COMPETITORS Steam has weak AI disclosure; Epic has none.

3. Xianyu Court Evidence Chaos • Heat 6/10 • AI Lifestyle

Buyer claims USB lost or damaged, seller insists it was fine.

STRATEGIC Trust is e-commerce core, AI arbitration cuts dispute costs.

INCUMBENTS Xianyu manual, Taobao support outdated.

TIMING Second-hand trade booming, disputes are UX bottleneck.
